## Kailua Elementary School Campus Rules

- 1. All students have a right to an education. When, in the judgment of school personnel, the behavior of a student disrupts activities and the learning of other members in school, the student will be held accountable and be expected to accept the consequences.
- Students will use proper manners and appropriate behavior throughout the school day. Students should be courteous and respectful to all on campus. Students will show respect for school and personal property.
- 3. Students will not arrive on campus before 7:15 am. Students shall leave the campus promptly at the end of the school day unless enrolled in a KES sponsored after school activity. They must stay in the respective areas of supervision at all times.
- 4. Students shall walk up and down stairs, along sidewalks and hallways, and inside all buildings at all times. Bicycles, scooter, skateboards and etc. are permitted as to and from school transportation only and must be walked on campus. They must be parked in assigned areas.
- 5. Contraband includes but is not limited to: electronic games and cigarettes; audio equipment (i.e. radios, CD players, headsets, stereos, etc.); cell phones; laser pointers; gum; any unlawful or dangerous items; balls, and trading cards. Items that disrupt learning will be confiscated. The school will not be responsible for contraband items lost or stolen in school. Contraband items will be confiscated and held in the office until picked up by a parent or guardian.
